Tuition

Payment Period

The payment period shall be the quarter. All tuition is due and payable on the first day of the payment period. Regardless of the Student’s funding source, all tuition must be paid in full thirty (30) days prior to the end of the payment period. The College reserves the right to withhold a grade report, diploma or transcript until all academic and financial requirements for the program have been met. Failure or withdrawal from a course does not give the Student the right to repeat the course without additional charges. A student who voluntarily withdraws from or is terminated by the College after starting classes is obligated to the College for tuition and fees as per the refund policy.

Optional Student Service and/or Non-refundable Fees:

The fees charged by the College are as follows:

1. Each student is entitled to one official copy of his/her official transcript and a diploma upon graduation. The additional transcript fee applies to any additional copies of official transcripts.
2. Students must be current with all financial obligations to the College in order to receive an official transcript and their diploma. Students may obtain unofficial transcripts at any time at no cost.
3. The bad check fee is charged for any check that is returned unpaid.
