## Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund II Report – Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students

## June 11, 2021

**Southern Technical College (OPE ID: 03903500)** received education stabilization funds under Section 314(a)(4) of the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA), Public Law No. 116-260. This Fund Report applies to funds received under the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund II which are designated exclusively for emergency financial aid grants to students. Southern Technical College operates four campuses in OPE ID 03903500 under Title IV regulations.

The institution appreciates that Congress and the President have made these critical funds available for eligible students who have expenses related to the coronavirus pandemic. We take receipt of these federal funds seriously and are distributing them in accordance with the CRRSAA and implementation guidance.

- 1. The institution signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement [for] Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students. The institution has used, or intends to use, the funds received under Section 314(a)(4) of the CRRSAA to provide emergency financial aid grants to students.
- 2. The total amount of funds that the institution will receive or has received from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement [for] Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students is \$1,359,543.
- 3. The total amount of emergency financial aid grants distributed to students under Section 314(a)(4) of the CRRSAA as of the date of this Fund Report is \$622,600.
- 4. The estimated total number of students at the institution eligible to receive emergency financial aid grants under Section 314(a)(4) of the CRRSAA, is 1503.
- 5. The total number of students who have received an emergency financial aid grant under Section 314(a)(4) of the CRRSAA as of the date of this Fund Report is 1,132.
- 6. The method used by the institution to determine which students receive emergency financial aid grants and how much they would receive under Section 314(a)(4) of the CRRSAA is:
  - i. The institution prioritized students with exceptional need, as required by CRRSAA, by selecting Pell eligible students who were active or on a leave of absence on February 15, 2021, who were negatively impacted by Covid-19 and therefore eligible for emergency relief.
