Tuition

The College's tuition charges for its programs are presented below. A set of required materials and textbooks are provided at no additional cost. The College reserves the right to modify tuition and other charges upon sufficient notice to students and appropriate agencies.

Payment Period

The payment period shall be the quarter. All tuition is due and payable on the first day of the payment period. Regardless of the Student's funding source, all tuition must be paid in full thirty (30) days prior to the end of the payment period. The College reserves the right to withhold a grade report, diploma or transcript until all academic and financial requirements for the program have been met. Failure or withdrawal from a course does not give the Student the right to repeat the course without additional charges. A student who voluntarily withdraws from or is terminated by the College after starting classes is obligated to the College for tuition and fees as per the refund policy.

Optional Student Service and/or Non-refundable Fees:
